- Prepare your slides or/and paper
- Give an amazing presentation
- Go back home



Coordinator's viewpoint

- Manage everything about speakers
- Manage everything about participants
- Manage everything about sponsors
- Manage everything about providers
- Manage everything about volunteers
- Anything else



Let's start

- Define your idea (your goal)
- Share it with the community (the people)
- Ask for help, organize a team.
- Redefine your idea and roadmap launch them.
 - Choose a good date
 - Look for a nice venue
 - Think about the possibilities for meals, accommodation and travelling.



Make it beautiful

- Prepare a nice proposal asking for participation.
- People should want going to your event.
- Make it easy, always thinking about your goal and launch it.
 - Website, mailing-lists, show the city, a nice program, nice weather:)

Call for participation (CFP,CFH)

- Ask people you are interested
- Publish the information on the web
- Make a good review of the proposals
 - Organize a team of advisors to review them.
 - Think about the format of the conference.
- Try to follow your roadmap
- People use to send them as later as possible and even later.



Publishing the program

- Prepare the registration form.. (Ideas)
- Open the registration and publish the program.
- Spread the news.
- * wait wait
- Lots of things to prepare: social events, material, volunteers, internet, booklet, meals, talks, rooms and venue, sponsors, marketing



Pre-event

- Think about people:
 - Visas
 - Sponsorship
 - Cheap accommodation
 - Try to solve all problems
 - Motivate the volunteers
 - anything you could not imagine.
